

Yeti Craft




To make a Yeti you will need:


- ½ Sheet of White Cardstock
- Colored Paper
- Approximately 12 Cotton Balls
- Elmer's Glue
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Tape
- Fine tip markers
- Glue Stick (optional)
- Construction paper, chenille stems, sequins, glitter glue, feathers, etc. (Optional for accessories.)

To make your Yeti:

1. Cut an approximate 4" strip of white cardstock.




2. Roll into a tube and tape together.



3. Cut two strips of white cardstock approximately 3" long and 3/4" wide for arms. Tape one on each side of the tube at arm height, about 1/4 of the way down the tube.



4. Cut an oval out of colored paper & draw a face. Glue onto the tube using a glue stick.



5. Stretch/tear cotton balls. Glue onto the body and arms. Keep gluing on cotton balls until your Yeti has as much fur as you want.



6. Fill in top of head by gluing in cotton, if desired. (*Tip - If you fold and glue some of the cotton balls over the top (head) hole it will help hold the other cotton balls on when you fill in to make the top of the head.)
7. (Optional) Lightly trace around the bottom of the Yeti onto card stock. Add feet to the traced circle. Cut out. Put Elmer's Glue on the bottom of the Yeti and press feet on.




8. (Optional) Make a top hat out of construction paper and decorate, make a crown out of chenille stems, or come up with an accessory of your own.




*Extra tips for making a Yeti with a group:


- Strips of cardstock for tube and arms can be precut. Tubes can be preassembled.
- Yeti can be covered with cotton balls as much or as little as desired.
- Glue can be put directly onto the tube for cotton to be pressed onto or cotton can be dipped into the glue.




Yeti face ↗




Yeti feet ↗




Yeti face ↗




Yeti feet ↗
